## A HOUSE RESOLUTION

- STATING FINDINGS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, SUPPORTING TEXAS IN SECUR ING ITS BORDERS, AND CONDEMNING PRESIDENT BIDEN'S BORDER SECURITY POLI CIES.
- 5 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, Texas Governor Greg Abbott has voiced great concern regarding
7 the federal government's failure to enforce immigration laws and protect the
8 states, leading to record levels of illegal immigration; and

9 WHEREAS, Governor Abbott has taken steps to protect Texas and secure its10 southern border; and

11 WHEREAS, President Biden has violated his constitutional duty to en-12 force federal laws protecting states, specifically immigration laws, as 13 outlined in the letters delivered by Governor Abbott; and

14 WHEREAS, President Biden's actions include instructing agencies to ig-15 nore federal statutes, suing the state of Texas for securing the border, and 16 spending taxpayer dollars to open Texas's border security infrastructure, 17 contributing to the influx of illegal immigrants; and

18 WHEREAS, the lawless border policies under President Biden's adminis-19 tration have resulted in over six million illegal immigrants crossing the 20 southern border in just three years, causing unprecedented harm to people 21 across the United States; and

22 WHEREAS, Governor Abbott has invoked Article I, Section 10, Clause 3
 23 of the United States Constitution in declaring an invasion and utilizing
 24 Texas's constitutional authority to defend and protect itself.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Represen-25 tatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-seventh Idaho 26 Legislature, that the House supports the concerns raised by Texas Governor 27 Greq Abbott regarding the federal government's failure to enforce immigra-28 tion laws and protect the states. The House condemns President Biden's vi-29 30 olations of his constitutional duty to faithfully execute immigration laws enacted by Congress and to protect and secure the borders and citizens of the 31 United States. 32

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Idaho House of Representatives recog-33 nizes the constitutional authority of the states, and the moral imperative 34 to defend and protect the states in the face of a failure by the federal gov-35 ernment to fulfill its duties under Article IV, Section 4 of the United State 36 Constitution. The Idaho House of Representatives expresses solidarity with 37 the State of Texas in utilizing its constitutional authority to secure the 38 Texas border, including the deployment of the Texas National Guard, the 39 Texas Department of Public Safety, and other Texas personnel. The Idaho 40 House of Representatives calls upon the federal government to fulfill its 41 duty under Article IV, Section 4 of the United States Constitution to protect 42

each state against invasion, including taking any and all actions to securethe borders and to address the challenges posed by illegal immigration.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the House of Representa-

4 tives be and she is hereby is authorized and directed to transmit a copy of

5 this Resolution to the Governor of Texas, Greg Abbott, and to the President

6 of the United States, Joseph R. Biden.
