6 7	WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), P.L. 117-2, was passed by Congress and signed into law; and

passed by Congress and signed into law; and WHEREAS, ARPA allocated \$1,094,018,353 to the State of Idaho for the

State Fiscal Recovery Fund; and

WHEREAS, projects associated with the State Fiscal Recovery Fund must be obligated by December 31, 2024, and expended by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, one of the four allowable uses of the State Fiscal Recovery Fund is to respond to the economic impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Shuttle service extradites parolees from 15 other states back to Idaho at no cost to the Commission of Pardons and Parole; and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Shuttle service suspended operations due to the impact of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Representatives, assembled in the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, that the House of Representatives supports the obligation of \$100,000 in ARPA funds for the extradition transport costs of the Commission of Pardons and Parole as bridge funding for extradition costs until a permanent solution can be found.
