AN ACT

- RELATING TO INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM ELECTIONS; AMENDING SECTION 34-1801A, 2 IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE FORM OF CERTAIN PE-3 TITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 34-1804, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS 4 5 RELATING TO CERTAIN SIGNATURE SHEETS; AMENDING SECTION 34-1805, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES RE-6 QUIRED ON CERTAIN PETITIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 34-1807, IDAHO CODE, 7 TO REVISE PROVISIONS RELATING TO CERTAIN PETITIONS AND SIGNATURE SHEETS 8 AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION. 9
- 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 34-1801A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 34-1801A. PETITION. The following shall be substantially the form of 14 petition for any law proposed by the initiative:

WARNING

16 It is a felony for anyone to sign any initiative or referendum petition with 17 any name other than his own, or to knowingly sign his name more than once for 18 the measure, or to sign such petition when he is not a qualified elector.

INITIATIVE PETITION

20 To the Honorable, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho:

"We, the undersigned citizens and qualified electors of the State of Idaho, 21 respectfully demand that the following proposed law, to-wit: (setting out 22 23 full text of measure proposed) shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the State of Idaho, for their approval or rejection at the regular general 24 election, to be held on the day of, A.D.,, and each for him-25 self says: I have personally signed this petition; I am a qualified elector 26 of the State of Idaho; my residence and post office legislative district are 27 correctly written after my name. 28

The petition for referendum on any act passed by the state legislature of the state of Idaho shall be in substantially the same form with appropriate title and changes, setting out in full the text of the act of the legislature to be referred to the people for their approval or rejection. 1 SECTION 2. That Section 34-1804, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 2 amended to read as follows:

34-1804. PRINTING OF PETITION AND SIGNATURE SHEETS. Before or at the 3 4 time of beginning to circulate any petition for the referendum to the people on any act passed by the state legislature of the state of Idaho, or for any 5 law proposed by the initiative, the person or persons or organization or or-6 ganizations under whose authority the measure is to be referred or initiated 7 shall send or deliver to the secretary of state a copy of such petition duly 8 signed by at least twenty (20) qualified electors of the state which shall 9 10 be filed by said officer in his office, and who shall immediately transmit a copy of the petition to the attorney general for the issuance of the cer-11 tificate of review as provided in section 34-1809, Idaho Code. All petitions 12 for the initiative and for the referendum and sheets for signatures shall be 13 printed on a good quality of bond or ledger paper in the form and manner as ap-14 15 proved by the secretary of state. To every sheet of petitioners' signatures shall be attached a full and correct copy of the measure so proposed by ini-16 tiative petition; but such petition may be filed by the secretary of state 17 in numbered sections for convenience in handling. Every sheet of petition-18 ers' signatures upon referendum petitions shall be attached to a full and 19 20 correct copy of the measure on which the referendum is demanded, and may be filed in numbered sections in like manner as initiative petitions. Not more 21 than twenty (20) signatures on one (1) sheet shall be counted. Each signa-22 ture sheet shall contain signatures of qualified electors from only one (1) 23 county and legislative district. 24

25 SECTION 3. That Section 34-1805, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 26 amended to read as follows:

34-1805. SPONSORS TO PRINT PETITION -- NUMBER OF SIGNERS REQUIRED. Af-27 ter the form of the initiative or referendum petition has been approved by 28 the secretary of state as in sections 34-1801A through 34-1822, Idaho Code, 29 provided, the same shall be printed by the person or persons or organization 30 or organizations under whose authority the measure is to be referred or ini-31 tiated and circulated in the several counties of the state for the signatures 32 of legal voters. Before such petitions shall be entitled to final filing and 33 34 consideration by the secretary of state there shall be affixed thereto the signatures of legal voters equal in number to not less than six percent (6%) 35 of the qualified electors at the time of the last general election in each of 36 at least twenty-two (22) legislative districts; provided however, the total 37 number of signatures shall be equal to or greater than six percent (6%) of the 38 qualified electors of the state at the time of the last general election. 39

40 SECTION 4. That Section 34-1807, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 41 amended to read as follows:

34-1807. CIRCULATION OF PETITIONS -- VERIFICATION OF PETITION AND
SIGNATURE SHEETS -- COMPARISON OF SIGNATURES WITH REGISTRATION OATHS AND
RECORDS -- CERTAIN PETITIONS AND SIGNATURES VOID. Any person who circulates
any petition for an initiative or referendum shall be a resident of the state
of Idaho and at least eighteen (18) years of age. Each and every sheet of

every such petition containing signatures shall be verified on the face 1 2 thereof in substantially the following form, by the person who circulated said sheet of said petition, by his or her affidavit thereon, and as a part 3 thereof: 4 5 State of Idaho₇ <u>)</u>)ss. 6 7 County of I,, being first duly sworn, say: That I am a resident of the State 8 of Idaho and at least eighteen (18) years of age: that every person who 9 signed this sheet of the foregoing petition signed his or her name thereto 10 11 in my presence: I believe that each has stated his or her name, post-office address legislative district and residence correctly, that each signer is a 12 qualified elector of the State of Idaho, and a resident of legislative dis-13 trict number in the county of 14 15 Signed..... 16 Post-office address Subscribed and sworn to before me this day of 17 18 (Notary Seal) Notary Public Residing at 19 20 In addition to said affidavit the county clerk shall carefully examine 21 said petitions and shall attach to the signature sheets a certificate to the secretary of state substantially as follows: 22 State of Idaho 23) 24)ss. The forms herein given are not mandatory and if sub-35 stantially followed in any petition, it shall be sufficient, disregarding 36 clerical and merely technical error. 37 Any petition upon which signatures are obtained by a person not a resi-38 39 dent of the state of Idaho and at least eighteen (18) years of age, shall be void. The definition of resident in section 34-107, Idaho Code, shall apply 40 to the circulators of initiative and referendum petitions. In addition to to 41 being a resident, a petition circulator shall be at least eighteen (18) years 42 of age. 43
