SENATE BILL NO. 1037

BY COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO WORKER'S COMPENSATION; AMENDING SECTION 72-305, IDAHO CODE, TO  
2 REMOVE A REQUIREMENT FOR IN-STATE ADJUSTING OFFICES OR OFFICERS; AND  
3 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 72-305, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 72-305. CLAIMS SERVICES AND MEDICAL SUPERVISION. Each surety shall  
9 provide prompt claims services through its own adjusting offices or officers  
10 ~~located within the state,~~ or by independent, licensed, ~~resident~~ adjusters.  
11 The surety shall provide medical supervision of cases from its insureds  
12 through medical consultants located within the state or near enough to pro-  
13 vide prompt and continuous service.

14 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
15 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after  
16 July 1, 2023.
