## SENATE BILL NO. 1050

2	RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTION; AMENDING CHAPTER 16, TITLE 16, IDAHO CODE,
3	BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 16-1648, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PRO-
4	VISIONS REGARDING A CERTAIN NOTIFICATION AND WAIVER; AND DECLARING AN
5	EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
ŝ	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
7	SECTION 1. That Chapter 16, Title 16, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
3	hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u> , to be known and des-
9	ignated as Section 16-1648, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:
10	16-1648. NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS. (1) When the department, in accor-
11	dance with this chapter, commences an investigation after having received
12	information that a child may be abused, neglected, or abandoned and in the
13	course of such investigation contacts, directly and in person, the parents
14	or any person or persons maintaining the custody and care of the child, then
15	the department shall notify such parents or persons that they have the right
16	to:
17	(a) Refuse to answer questions;
18	(b) Consult with an attorney and have an attorney present during an in-
19	vestigation;
20	<ul><li>(c) Refuse entry to their home or other real property; and</li><li>(d) Refuse the questioning of any minor children in their home or on</li></ul>
21 22	their property, unless there is a warrant or order issued by a court of
23	competent jurisdiction authorizing a particular entry or particular
24 24	questioning or examination.
25	(2) The notification required by subsection (1) of this section shall
26	be made in writing within seventy-two (72) hours after the department's
27	first contact with the parents or concerned persons.
28	(3) A parent or concerned person may waive effectuation of the rights
29	provided in subsection (1) of this section. Such waiver must be made volun-
30	tarily, knowingly, and intelligently.
31	(4) The notification required by subsection (1) of this section shall
32	be made in writing on a form that includes the following:

Be advised that you are the subject of an investigation by the

Idaho Department of Health and Welfare for potential child

abuse, abandonment, or neglect. This is not an indication

- that you are the subject of a criminal investigation. Now and throughout this investigation, you have certain rights.
- 1. You have the right to refuse interviews and to refuse to answer questions.
- You have the right to refuse entry to your home or other
  premises, unless there is a warrant or an order of a court
  granting entry to your home or other premises.
- You have the right to consult with an attorney at your own
  expense and to have that attorney present during interactions
  with the department.
- 4. You have the right to refuse the questioning of minor children in your home or on your property if there is no warrant or order of a court to examine your children.
- If you have waived all or some of your rights as explained and change your mind during the investigation, please inform the department immediately of your desire to exercise your rights.
- 18 (5) The parents or any person or persons maintaining the custody and 19 care of the child shall have standing to challenge a violation of the provi-20 sions of this section, and such parents or persons shall be awarded costs and 21 attorney's fees in the event that such challenge prevails.
- SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2023.
