7 59-1019. FACSIMILE SIGNATURE.

8 (1) (a) Any authorized officer, after filing with the secretary of state
 9 his manual signature certified by him under oath, may execute or cause
 10 to be executed with a facsimile signature in lieu of his manual signa 11 ture:

- (ai) Any public security, provided that at least one (1) signature required or permitted to be placed thereon shall be manually subscribed, and
 - (<u>bii</u>) Any instrument of payment.

(b) Upon compliance with this act by the authorized officer, his fac simile signature has the same legal effect as his manual signature.

- (2) (a) The governor, after filing with the secretary of state his man ual signature certified by him under oath, may execute or cause to be ex ecuted with a facsimile signature in lieu of his manual signature:
- (ai) All instruments, documents, and papers requiring his signature which that originate with the state board of land commissioners or department of public lands, except deeds of the public lands
 of the state; and
- (bii) All instruments, documents, and papers acted upon by the
 state board of examiners; and
