7	SECTION 1. That Section 18-7034, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
3	amended to read as follows:
9	18-7034. UNLAWFUL ENTRY A MISDEMEANOR. (1) Every person, except under
10	landlord-tenant relationship, who enters any dwelling house, apartment,
11	tenement, shop, warehouse, store, mill, barn, stable, outhouse or other
12	building, tent, vessel, closed vehicle, closed trailer, airplane, railroad
13	car or outbuilding, without the consent of the owner of such property or his
14	agent or any person in lawful possession thereof, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
15	(2) Any person who enters any permanent or temporary dwelling without
16	the consent of the owner of such property or his agent or any person in law-
17	ful possession thereof while being pursued by a peace officer is guilty of a
18	felony. For purposes of this subsection "pursued" means "fresh pursuit" as
