SENATE BILL NO. 1122

BY JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO COMMISSIONERS ON UNIFORM LAWS; AMENDING SECTION 67-1701, IDAHO
2 CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN PERSONS SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION
3 ON UNIFORM STATE LAWS; AMENDING SECTION 67-1702, IDAHO CODE, TO CLARIFY
4 THAT A COMMISSIONER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL HAVE A CERTAIN TERM
5 OF OFFICE AND TO CLARIFY PER DIEM PAYMENTS TO LIFE MEMBER COMMISSIONERS;
6 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 67-1701, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 67-1701. APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS -- QUALIFICATIONS -- VACAN-
12 CIES. The governor shall appoint four (4) commissioners, each of whom shall
13 be a member of the bar of this state, in good standing, who shall constitute
14 and be known as the commission on uniform state laws, and upon the death,
15 resignation or refusal to serve of any of the commissioners so appointed,
16 the governor shall make an appointment to fill the vacancy so caused, such
17 new appointment to be for the unexpired balance of the term of the original
18 appointee. In addition thereto, any commissioner that has previously served
19 as a member of the commission and has been elected a life member of the na-
20 tional conference of commissioners on uniform state laws shall be a member of
21 the commission. The commission shall be within the office of the secretary
22 of state.

23 SECTION 2. That Section 67-1702, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
24 amended to read as follows:

25 67-1702. TERM OF OFFICE -- DISBURSEMENTS FOR EXPENSES. Each ~~of said~~
26 ~~commissioners~~ appointed by the governor shall hold office for a term of four
27 (4) years, and until his successor is duly appointed, but nothing herein con-
28 tained shall be construed to render a commissioner who has faithfully per-
29 formed his duties ineligible for reappointment. No member of said commis-
30 sion shall receive any compensation for his services as commissioner, but
31 each commissioner, including life member commissioners, shall be entitled
32 to receive his actual disbursements for expenses in performing the duties of
33 his office.

34 SECTION 3. This act shall be in full force and effect on and after July
35 1, 2018.
