- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 54-5705, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 7 amended to read as follows:

8 54-5705. PROVIDER-PATIENT RELATIONSHIP. (1) If a provider offering telehealth services does not have an established provider-patient re-9 lationship with a person seeking such services, the provider shall take 10 appropriate steps to establish a provider-patient relationship by use of 11 12 two-way audio or audio-visual interaction telehealth technologies sufficient to diagnose and appropriate to treat the patient with the condition as 13 presented; provided however, that the applicable Idaho community standard 14 of care must be satisfied. Nothing in this section shall prohibit electronic 15 16 communications:

(a) Between a provider and a patient with a preexisting provider-pa-tient relationship;

(b) Between a provider and another provider concerning a patient with
 whom the other provider has a provider-patient relationship;

(c) Between a provider and a patient where the provider is taking call
 on behalf of another provider in the same community who has a provider patient relationship with the patient; or

24 (d) In an emergency.

(2) As used in this section, "emergency" means a situation in which
 there is an occurrence that poses an imminent threat of a life-threatening
 condition or severe bodily harm.
