SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor and 26 the State Controller shall transfer \$2,500,000 from the General Fund to the 27 28 Workforce Development Training Fund, on July 1, 2017, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the period July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018. 29

SECTION 4. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, 30 Idaho Code, the Department of Labor is authorized no more than seven hundred 31 (700) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 32 33 2017, through June 30, 2018, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. 34 The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized. 35

SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby declared to exist, the provisions of Section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect on and after passage and approval.
