5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
Idaho Code, the Department of Commerce is authorized no more than forty-six
(46) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1,
2015, through June 30, 2016, unless specifically authorized by the Governor.
The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any
increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Commerce
 and the State Controller shall transfer \$1,750,000 from the General Fund to
 the Idaho Opportunity Fund, through installments or as practicable for the
 period July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016.
