2 APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE COMMISSION ON AGING FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018; AND LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commission on Aging, the following amounts to be expended for the designated expense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018:

The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.
