5	TERM, AND TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO APPLICABILITY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 1, Title 38, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a  $\underline{\text{NEW SECTION}}$ , to be known and designated as Section 38-137, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

- 38-137. EXPLODING TARGETS -- PERIOD OF PROHIBITED USE -- VIOLATION -- APPLICABILITY. (1) The use of exploding targets is prohibited on public lands during the closed season for fires as provided for in section 38-115, Idaho Code.
- (2) Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be deemed a misdemeanor. In addition to any other punishment imposed, or cost recovery allowed by law, the court shall have discretion to order a person committing a violation of this section to perform community service in remediation efforts associated with damages caused by a fire resulting from the person's violation.
- (3) The provisions of section 38-107, Idaho Code, shall apply to any fire caused by an exploding target as provided for in this section.
- (4) As used in this section, "exploding target" means a device designed for use as a target consisting of a substance or substances capable of exploding or igniting when struck by a bullet or projectile.
- (5) The provisions of this section shall not apply to exploding targets when used on any shooting range that has a permit or governmental approval, whether located on public or private land.
