AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR 2 FISCAL YEAR 2022; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRON-3 MENTAL QUALITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED 4 5 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIA-6 TION TRIUMPH MINE FUND; PROVIDING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING 7 REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND; APPROPRIATING AND 8 TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY GEN-9 10 ERAL FUND TO THE AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES FUND; APPROPRI-ATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE AGRICULTURAL 11 BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES FUND; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS 12 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND; APPROPRI-13 ATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL 14 QUALITY GENERAL FUND TO THE AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES 15 FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 16

## 17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, 13 Idaho Code, the Department of Environmental Quality is authorized no more 14 than three hundred seventy-nine (379.00) full-time equivalent positions 15 at any point during the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, unless 16 specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations 17 Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so autho-18 19 rized.

SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER FOR TRIUMPH MINE. There is hereby appropriated 20 21 to the Department of Environmental Quality and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$1,500,000 from the Water Pollution Control Fund to 22 23 the Environmental Remediation (Triumph Mine) Fund on July 1, 2021, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, 24 to be used for remediation, maintenance, and monitoring of conditions at the 25 Triumph Mine. 26

SECTION 4. REMEDIATION PROJECT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. Moneys de-27 posited into the Environmental Remediation (Basin) Fund shall be used for 28 remediation of the Coeur d'Alene Basin in accordance with the Superfund con-29 tract with the Environmental Protection Agency. The Department of Environ-30 31 mental Quality shall file an annual report with the Governor, Legislature, and Coeur d'Alene Basin Environmental Improvement Project Commission on the 32 remediation progress and the expenditures involved. 33

SECTION 5. USES OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND. The appropriation 34 35 of moneys from the Water Pollution Control Fund in this act shall specifically supersede the provisions of Section 39-3630, Idaho Code. 36

SECTION 6. CASH TRANSFER FOR AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES 37 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY GENERAL FUND. Of the amount 38 39 appropriated in Section 1 of this act, there is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$279,000 from the Department 40 of Environmental Quality (General) Fund to the Agricultural Best Management 41

Practices (BMP) Fund on July 1, 2021, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

3 SECTION 7. CASH TRANSFER FOR AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES 4 FROM THE GENERAL FUND. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the 5 State Controller shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the General Fund to the 6 Agricultural Best Management Practices (BMP) Fund on July 1, 2021, or as soon 7 thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

8 SECTION 8. CASH TRANSFER TO THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND. There is
9 hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer
10 \$8,181,700 from the General Fund to the Water Pollution Control Fund on July
11 1, 2021, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2021,
12 through June 30, 2022.

SECTION 9. CASH TRANSFER FOR AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021. There is hereby appropriated and the Office of the State Controller shall transfer \$284,700 from the Department of Environmental Quality (General) Fund to the Agricultural Best Management Practices (BMP) Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.

SECTION 10. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 declared to exist, Section 9 of this act shall be in full force and effect on
 and after passage and approval.
