- RELATING TO THE CAPITOL MALL; AMENDING CHAPTER 57, TITLE 67, IDAHO CODE, BY
 THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 67-5709B, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE
 ADMINISTRATOR OF THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL DEVELOP FACILITIES
 IN THE CAPITOL MALL AND TO CREATE A PROCESS FOR EXEMPTING CAPITOL MALL
 FACILITIES FROM PLANNING AND ZONING RESTRICTIONS; AND DECLARING AN
 EMERGENCY.
- 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Chapter 57, Title 67, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
10 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des11 ignated as Section 67-5709B, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

12 67-5709B. DEVELOPMENT OF FACILITIES. To the extent funds are available therefor, the administrator of the division of public works shall 13 develop state-owned facilities or facilities constructed through the state 14 building authority within the state capitol mall. The state capitol mall 15 shall include the capitol mall properties set forth in section 67-5709, 16 Idaho Code, or in rules promulgated pursuant thereto. Notwithstanding any 17 other provisions of law to the contrary, the director of the department of 18 administration, subject to the approval of the permanent building fund ad-19 visory council, may exempt facilities within the capitol mall from local 20 land use planning ordinances established pursuant to chapter 65, title 67, 21 22 Idaho Code. Neither the designation of facilities as exempt from local land 23 use planning ordinances by the director nor the approval of the permanent building fund advisory council shall be subject to judicial review under the 24 provisions of chapter 52, title 67, Idaho Code. 25

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
 passage and approval.
