SECTION 2. WAIVER FUNDING REQUIREMENTS. If any federal waiver provided for in Senate Bill No. 1204 , As Amended, As Amended in the House, as enacted by the First Regular Session of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, is not approved by the appropriate federal government authorizing agency, any
funding provided in Section 1 of this act that has not already been expended or encumbered shall revert to its original funding source. Further, the Department of Health and Welfare shall provide to the Legislature detailed reports on all expenditures made for each required waiver. The department shall submit these reports and, as needed, present a status update to the Legislature by October 1, 2019, and again by January 3, 2020.
