### SENATE BILL NO. 1247

#### BY RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

#### AN ACT

- RELATING TO WOLVES; AMENDING CHAPTER 11, TITLE 36, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD DITION OF A NEW SECTION 36-1107A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR CHRONIC
   DEPREDATION ZONES, TO PROVIDE FOR WOLF-FREE ZONES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR
   THE APPLICABILITY OF SPECIFIED PROVISIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 11, Title 36, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 36-1107A, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

36-1107A. CHRONIC DEPREDATION ZONES -- WOLF-FREE ZONES. (1) Wolves 10 may be taken year-round in any chronic depredation zone. Any hunter so 11 taking a wolf shall have a valid hunting license and a wolf tag and shall 12 report the take to the department of fish and game within seven (7) days 13 of such take. For purposes of this subsection, "chronic depredation zone" 14 means any big game hunting unit as designated by the fish and game commis-15 sion wherein the commission or the United States department of agriculture 16 animal and plant health inspection service (USDA APHIS) wildlife services 17 has confirmed depredation in four (4) out of the immediate five (5) preceding 18 calendar years. 19

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this section,
big game hunting units 38, 40, 41, 42, 46, 47, 53, 54, 55, 56, and 57 are
hereby designated as wolf-free zones. Wolves may be taken year-round in any
wolf-free zone. Any hunter so taking a wolf shall have a valid hunting license and a wolf tag and shall report the take to the department within seven
(7) days of such take.

(3) The provisions of this section shall be in effect as long as there 26 are more than twenty (20) packs, consisting of at least two hundred (200) 27 wolves, in the state of Idaho. In the event the number of packs falls to 28 twenty (20) packs, consisting of at least two hundred (200) wolves or less, 29 the commission is authorized to review wolf management policies and take 30 appropriate action to restore the number of packs of wolves in the state to a 31 minimum of twenty (20) packs, consisting of at least two hundred (200) wolves 32 33 or more.

34 SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 35 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after its
 36 passage and approval.
