1 RELATING TO THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL; AMENDING SEC-
2 TION 19-5101, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A DEFINITION AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL
3 CORRECTIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 19-5101, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 19-5101. DEFINITIONS. As used in this act:

9 (a) "Council" means the Idaho peace officer standards and training
10 council.

11 (b) "County detention officer" means an employee in a county jail who is
12 responsible for the safety, care, protection, and monitoring of county jail
13 inmates.

14 (c) "Law enforcement" means any and all activities pertaining to crime
15 prevention or reduction and law enforcement, including police, courts,
16 prosecution, corrections, probation, rehabilitation, and juvenile delin-
17 quency.

18 (d) "Peace officer" means any employee or volunteer reserve officer of
19 a police or law enforcement agency which is a part of or administered by the
20 state or any political subdivision thereof and whose duties include and pri-
21 marily consist of the prevention and detection of crime and the enforcement
22 of penal, traffic or highway laws of this state or any political subdivi-
23 sion. "Peace officer" also means an employee of a police or law enforcement
24 agency of a federally recognized Indian tribe who has satisfactorily com-
25 pleted the peace officer standards and training academy and has been depu-
26 tized by a sheriff of a county or a chief of police of a city of the state of
27 Idaho.

28 (e) "Political subdivision" means any city or county.
