## SENATE BILL NO. 1251

- RELATING TO THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL; AMENDING SEC-2 TION 19-5101, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE A DEFINITION AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL 3 CORRECTIONS. 4
- Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 5
- SECTION 1. That Section 19-5101, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 6 amended to read as follows: 7
- 8 19-5101. DEFINITIONS. As used in this act:
- (a) "Council" means the Idaho peace officer standards and training 9 council. 10
- (b) "County detention officer" means an employee in a county jail who is 11 12 responsible for the safety, care, protection, and monitoring of county jail inmates. 13
- (c) "Law enforcement" means any and all activities pertaining to crime 14 prevention or reduction and law enforcement, including police, courts, 15 prosecution, corrections, probation, rehabilitation, and juvenile delin-16 quency. 17
- (d) "Peace officer" means any employee or volunteer reserve officer of 18 a police or law enforcement agency which is a part of or administered by the 19 state or any political subdivision thereof and whose duties include and pri-20 marily consist of the prevention and detection of crime and the enforcement 21 22 of penal, traffic or highway laws of this state or any political subdivi-23 sion. "Peace officer" also means an employee of a police or law enforcement 24 agency of a federally recognized Indian tribe who has satisfactorily completed the peace officer standards and training academy and has been depu-25 tized by a sheriff of a county or a chief of police of a city of the state of 26 27 Idaho.

  - (e) "Political subdivision" means any city or county.
