 CODE, TO DEFINE A PHRASE AND TO REVISE A PROVISION REGARDING CERTAIN
 DOCUMENTATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
 DATE.
- 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 58-1312, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 8 amended to read as follows:

58-1312. PERMITTING OF EXISTING ENCROACHMENTS. (1) Unless otherwise 9 prohibited, every person seeking a permit for a navigational or nonnavi-10 gational encroachment constructed prior to January 1, 1975, shall provide 11 12 the board with substantive documentation of the age of the encroachment and documentation that the encroachment has not been modified since 1974. For 13 purposes of this section, the phrase "has not been modified" means that the 14 overall footprint of the encroachment on the lake bed has not changed in 15 dimension, orientation, height, or location. Persons providing such docu-16 mentation shall receive an encroachment permit and shall not be required to 17 pay the application and publication fees established in this chapter. Such 18 substantive documentation shall include but not be limited to dated aerial 19 photographs, tax records, or other historical information deemed reliable 20 21 by the board.

(2) Every person seeking a permit for a navigational or nonnavigational
 encroachment constructed, replaced or modified on or after January 1, 1975,
 shall submit a permit application and enter the same permitting process as
 required for new encroachments.

SECTION 2. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after
 July 1, 2024.
