### SENATE BILL NO. 1273

#### AN ACT

- 2 RELATING TO INSURANCE; AMENDING CHAPTER 18, TITLE 41, IDAHO CODE, BY THE AD 3 DITION OF A NEW SECTION 41-1852, IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH PROVISIONS RE 4 GARDING COVERAGE OF ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS UNDER HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS.
- 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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6 SECTION 1. That Chapter 18, Title 41, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 7 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and des-8 ignated as Section 41-1852, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

9 41-1852. ANTICANCER MEDICATIONS. (1) For purposes of this section:
10 (a) "Anticancer medication" means a drug or biologic used to kill, slow
11 or prevent the growth of cancerous cells.

(b) "Health benefit plan" shall have the same meaning as provided insection 41-5903, Idaho Code.

(2) A health benefit plan covering anticancer medications that are in-14 jected or intravenously administered by a health care provider and patient-15 administered anticancer medications, including, but not limited to, those 16 medications that are orally administered or self-injected, may not require 17 a higher copayment, deductible or coinsurance amount for patient-adminis-18 tered anticancer medications than it requires for injected or intravenously 19 administered anticancer medications, regardless of the formulation or bene-20 fit category determination by the health benefit plan. 21

(3) A health benefit plan may not comply with the provisions of subsection (2) of this section by:

(a) Increasing the copayment, deductible or coinsurance amount re quired for injected or intravenously administered anticancer medica tions that are covered under the health benefit plan; or

(b) Reclassifying benefits with respect to anticancer medications.
