SENATE BILL NO. 1278

BY RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING SECTION 36-407, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE
2 NONRESIDENT DISABLED AMERICAN VETERAN LICENSE PROVISIONS TO ALLOW
3 CERTAIN PERSONS TO HUNT, PURCHASE TAGS AND FISH PURSUANT TO SPECIFIED
4 PROVISIONS, TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION RELATING TO FISHING, TO PROVIDE
5 THAT CERTAIN NONRESIDENTS MAY BE ISSUED LICENSES TO FISH FOR THREE
6 CONSECUTIVE DAYS EACH LICENSE YEAR PURSUANT TO SPECIFIED PROVISIONS,
7 TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION RELATING TO FISHING AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL
8 CORRECTIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 36-416, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE FEE
9 PROVISIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

12 SECTION 1. That Section 36-407, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
13 amended to read as follows:

14 36-407. NONRESIDENT COMBINATION, FISHING, HUNTING, AND TRAPPING LI-
15 CENSES -- FEES -- RIGHTS UNDER. Licenses of the sixth class shall be issued to
16 nonresidents in the several kinds and for fees as follows:

17 (a) Nonresident Hunting ~~W~~with Three Day Fishing License. A license is-
18 sued only to a person twelve (12) years of age or older entitling said per-
19 son to hunt game animals, game birds and unprotected and predatory wildlife
20 and to purchase game tags as provided in section 36-409(b), Idaho Code, and
21 to fish in the waters of the state for a period of three (3) consecutive days
22 for any fish during an open season for those fish, excluding steelhead trout
23 and anadromous salmon. Provided, that a license may be issued to qualified
24 persons who are eleven (11) years of age to allow the application for a con-
25 trolled hunt tag; however, said persons shall not hunt until they are twelve
26 (12) years of age. A license of this kind may be had upon payment of a fee as
27 specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code.

28 (b) Nonresident Season Fishing License. A license entitling a person
29 to fish in the public waters of the state. A license of this kind may be had
30 upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code.

31 (c) Nonresident Trapping License. A license entitling a person to trap
32 wolves, fur-bearing, unprotected and predatory wildlife. A license of this
33 kind may be had upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho
34 Code, providing the state of residence of said person grants similar trap-
35 ping license privileges to residents of Idaho.

36 (d) Nonresident Nongame License. A nonresident nongame license to hunt
37 is a license entitling a person to hunt unprotected birds and animals and
38 predatory wildlife of this state. A license of this kind may be had by a non-
39 resident person who is twelve (12) years of age or older upon payment of a fee
40 as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code.

41 (e) Nonresident Small Game Hunting License. A license issued only to
42 a person twelve (12) years of age or older, entitling the person to hunt up-

1 land game birds (to include turkeys), migratory game birds, upland game ani-
2 mals, huntable fur-bearing animals, and unprotected and predatory wildlife
3 of this state. A person holding this license shall purchase the appropriate
4 required tags and permits, and may not hunt pheasants in an area during the
5 first five (5) days of the pheasant season in that area. A license of this
6 type may be had upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho
7 Code.

8 (f) Falconry Meet Permit. The director may issue a special permit for a
9 regulated meet scheduled for a specific number of days upon payment of a fee
10 as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code. Only trained raptors may be used
11 under the special permit issued under the provisions of this subsection.

12 (g) Daily Fishing License -- Resident May Purchase. A license enti-
13 tling a person to fish in the waters of the state on a day-to-day basis. A
14 license of this kind may be had by a resident or nonresident person (the pro-
15 visions of section 36-405, Idaho Code, notwithstanding), upon payment of a
16 fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code, for the first effective day
17 and a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code, for each consecutive
18 day thereafter.

19 (h) Nonresident Three Day Fishing License with Steelhead or Salmon
20 Permit. A license entitling a nonresident to fish in the waters of the state
21 for a period of three (3) consecutive days for any fish, including steelhead
22 trout or anadromous salmon during an open season for those fish may be had
23 upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code. The three
24 (3) day license holder may fish for any species of fish, steelhead trout and
25 anadromous salmon subject to the limitations prescribed in rules promul-
26 gated by the commission. A nonresident may purchase as many of the licenses
27 provided in this subsection as he desires provided that the nonresident is
28 otherwise eligible to do so.

29 (i) Nonresident Junior Fishing License. A license entitling a nonresi-
30 dent who is less than eighteen (18) years of age to fish in the waters of this
31 state may be had upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho
32 Code.

33 (j) Nonresident Combination Licenses. A license entitling the per-
34 son to hunt and fish for game animals, game birds, fish and unprotected and
35 predatory wildlife of the state and to purchase game tags as provided in
36 section 36-409(b), Idaho Code, may be had by a person twelve (12) years of age
37 or older upon payment of a fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code. A
38 license may be issued to a qualified person who is eleven (11) years of age to
39 allow the application for a controlled hunt tag; however, the person shall
40 not hunt until he is twelve (12) years of age.

41 (k) Nonresident Junior Mentored Hunting License. A license entitling
42 a nonresident between ten (10) and seventeen (17) years of age, inclusive,
43 to hunt big game animals, upland game birds (including turkeys), migratory
44 game birds, upland game animals, huntable furbearing animals and unpro-
45 tected and predatory wildlife of this state only when accompanied in the
46 field by the holder of an adult Idaho hunting license. A person holding this
47 license shall purchase the appropriate required tags as provided in section
48 36-409(b), Idaho Code, and permits. Provided, that a license may be issued
49 to qualified persons who are nine (9) years of age to allow the application
50 for a controlled hunt turkey permit; however, said persons shall not hunt

1 until they are ten (10) years of age. Persons with a nonresident junior men-
 2 tored hunting license who are ten (10) or eleven (11) years of age shall not
 3 hunt big game animals. A license of this kind may be had upon payment of a fee
 4 as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code.

5 (l) Nonresident Disabled American Veteran Hunting with Three Day Fish-
 6 ing License. A license entitling a person to ~~participate in a hunt in asso-~~
 7 ~~ciation with a qualified organization. "Qualified organization," as used in~~
 8 ~~association with these licenses, shall be as defined in section 36-408(7),~~
 9 ~~Idaho Code with a service-connected veterans disability benefit with forty~~
 10 ~~percent (40%) or more disability to hunt game animals, game birds and unpro-~~
 11 ~~ected and predatory wildlife and to purchase game tags provided in section~~
 12 ~~36-409(b), Idaho Code, and to fish in the waters of the state for a period of~~
 13 ~~three (3) consecutive days for any fish during an open season for those fish,~~
 14 ~~excluding steelhead trout and anadromous salmon.~~

15 (em) Nonresident Hunting License -- Three Year. A license issued only
 16 to a person twelve (12) years of age or older entitling said person to hunt
 17 game birds, game animals, unprotected and predatory wildlife and to purchase
 18 game tags as provided in section 36-409(b), Idaho Code, and to fish in the wa-
 19 ters of the state for a period of three (3) consecutive days in each license
 20 year for any fish during an open season for those fish, excluding steelhead
 21 trout and anadromous salmon. Provided, that a license may be issued to qual-
 22 ified persons who are eleven (11) years of age to allow the application for
 23 a controlled hunt tag; however, said persons shall not hunt until they are
 24 twelve (12) years of age. A license of this kind may be had upon payment of
 25 three (3) times the fee as specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code. The expi-
 26 ration date for said license shall be December 31 of the third year following
 27 the date of issuance.

28 (pn) Nonresident Season Fishing License -- Three Year. A license en-
 29 titling a person to fish in the public waters of the state. A license of
 30 this kind may be had upon payment of three (3) times the fee as specified in
 31 section 36-416, Idaho Code, for a fishing license. The expiration date for
 32 said license shall be December 31 of the third year following the date of
 33 issuance.

34 (eo) Nonresident Combination Licenses -- Three Year. A license enti-
 35 tling the person to hunt and fish for game animals, game birds, fish and un-
 36 protected and predatory wildlife of the state may be had by a person twelve
 37 (12) years of age or older upon payment of three (3) times the fee as spec-
 38 ified in section 36-416, Idaho Code, for a combined hunting and fishing li-
 39 cense. A license may be issued to a qualified person who is eleven (11) years
 40 of age to allow the application for a controlled hunt tag; however, the per-
 41 son shall not hunt until he is twelve (12) years of age. The expiration date
 42 for said license shall be December 31 of the third year following the date of
 43 issuance.

44 (xp) Nonresident Junior Mentored Hunting License -- Three Year. A li-
 45 cense entitling a nonresident between ten (10) and seventeen (17) years of
 46 age, inclusive, to hunt game animals, upland game birds (including turkeys),
 47 migratory game birds, and unprotected and predatory wildlife of this state
 48 only when accompanied in the field by the holder of an adult Idaho hunting
 49 license. A person holding this license shall purchase the appropriate re-
 50 quired tags as provided in section 36-409(b), Idaho Code, and permits. Pro-

1 vided, that a license may be issued to qualified persons who are nine (9)
 2 years of age to allow the application for a controlled hunt turkey permit;
 3 however, said persons shall not hunt until they are ten (10) years of age.
 4 A license of this kind may be had upon payment of three (3) times the fee as
 5 specified in section 36-416, Idaho Code, for a junior mentored hunting li-
 6 cense. The expiration date for said license shall be December 31 of the third
 7 year following the date of issuance.

8 SECTION 2. That Section 36-416, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
 9 amended to read as follows:

10 36-416. SCHEDULE OF LICENSE FEES. As used in this section, "N/A" means
 11 "not available."
