2 RELATING TO ADMINISTRATORS OF RESIDENTIAL CARE OR ASSISTED LIVING FACILI-
3 TIES; AMENDING SECTION 39-3321, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE QUALIFICATIONS
4 FOR ADMINISTRATORS OF RESIDENTIAL CARE OR ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 39-3321, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 39-3321. QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF ADMINISTRATOR. Each res-
9 idential care or assisted living facility must employ at least one (1) admin-
10 istrator licensed by the bureau of occupational licensing, which is respon-
11 sible for licensing residential care facility administrators for the state
12 of Idaho. Multiple facilities under one (1) administrator ~~may~~ shall be al-
13 lowed by the department ~~based on an approved plan of operation.~~ An adminis-
14 trator shall be allowed to oversee up to four (4) qualified house managers of
15 a small facility that is defined as sixteen (16) bed or less. The department
16 shall promulgate applicable rules, through negotiated rulemaking with the
17 council, to define a qualified house manager. Operating a nursing facility
18 and an attached assisted living facility shall not be deemed operating two
19 (2) buildings with one (1) license.
