SENATE BILL NO. 1349

AN ACT

- RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS AND BICYCLES; AMENDING SECTION 2 49-702, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT NO PEDESTRIAN, BICYCLIST OR 3 4 HUMAN-POWERED VEHICLE SHALL SUDDENLY LEAVE A CURB OR OTHER PLACE OF SAFETY AND WALK, RUN OR RIDE INTO THE PATH OF A VEHICLE; AND AMENDING 5 CHAPTER 7, TITLE 49, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-725, 6 IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT EVERY BICYCLE, WHEN OPERATED UPON A ROADWAY, 7 SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH AT LEAST ONE BRAKE ADEQUATE TO CONTROL THE 8 MOVEMENT AND TO STOP AND HOLD SUCH BICYCLE. 9
- 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 49-702, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

49-702. PEDESTRIANS' <u>AND BICYCLISTS'</u> RIGHT-OF-WAY IN CROSSWALKS. (1)
When traffic-control signals are not in place or not in operation the driver
of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, slowing down or stopping, if need
be, to yield to a pedestrian crossing the highway within a crosswalk.

(2) No pedestrian, bicyclist or operator of a human-powered vehicle
shall suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk, or run or ride
into the path of a vehicle which is so close as to constitute an immediate
hazard.

(3) Subsection (1) of this section shall not apply under the conditions
 stated in section 49-704(2), Idaho Code.

(4) Whenever any vehicle is stopped at a marked crosswalk or at an
unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to permit a pedestrian to cross the
highway, the driver of any other vehicle approaching from the rear shall not
overtake and pass the stopped vehicle.

(5) Except where otherwise indicated by a crosswalk or other
traffic-control devices a pedestrian shall cross the highway at right
angles to the curb or by the shortest route to the opposite curb.

30 SECTION 2. That Chapter 7, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is 31 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and 32 designated as Section 49-725, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

49-725. BICYCLE EQUIPMENT -- REQUIRED. Every bicycle, when operated
 upon a roadway of this state, shall be equipped with at least one brake
 adequate to control the movement of such bicycle and to stop and hold such
 bicycle.
