- 2 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRON-3 MENTAL QUALITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED 4 5 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION BASIN FUND; EXPRESSING LEGISLATIVE 6 INTENT REGARDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION BASIN FUND AND REQUIR-7 ING AN ANNUAL REPORT; EXPRESSING LEGISLATIVE INTENT WITH REGARD TO 8 USE OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT 9 10 REGARDING USE OF CERTAIN MONEYS FOR AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRAC-TICES; AND PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION FOR CERTAIN PROGRAMS. 11
- 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
 Idaho Code, the Department of Environmental Quality is authorized no more
 than three hundred eighty-six (386.00) full-time equivalent positions at

any point during the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, unless
specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations
Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

5 SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER FOR WASTE REMEDIATION. There is hereby appro-6 priated to the Department of Environmental Quality and the State Controller 7 shall transfer \$1,500,000 from the Water Pollution Control Fund to the Envi-8 ronmental Remediation (Basin) Fund through monthly installments or as prac-9 ticable for the period July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, to be used for Su-10 perfund cleanup projects in the Coeur d'Alene Basin.

SECTION 4. REMEDIATION PROJECT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. It is the in-11 tent of the Legislature that moneys deposited into the Environmental Remedi-12 ation (Basin) Fund are to be used for remediation of the Coeur d'Alene Basin 13 14 in accordance with the Superfund contract with the Environmental Protection Agency. The Department of Environmental Quality shall file an annual re-15 port with the Governor, Legislature, and Coeur d'Alene Basin Environmental 16 Improvement Project Commission on the remediation progress and the expendi-17 tures involved. 18

SECTION 5. USES OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FUND. It is the intent
 of the Legislature that the appropriation of moneys from the Water Pollution
 Control Fund in this act specifically supersedes the provisions of Section
 39-3630, Idaho Code.

SECTION 6. AGRICULTURAL BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES. It is the intent of 23 the Legislature that \$500,000 of the ongoing General Fund moneys appropri-24 ated to the Water Quality Program for trustee and benefit payments in Sec-25 tion 1 of this act be used for a statewide grant program to support imple-26 mentation of agricultural Best Management Practices (BMPs) in high-prior-27 ity watersheds throughout Idaho. The department is to administer this fund-28 ing through existing BMP grant procedures and personnel. Funding is to be 29 used by farmers and ranchers to modify their agricultural practices in order 30 to improve water quality and help meet the objectives of Total Maximum Daily 31 32 Loads (TMDLs).

33 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated 34 to the Department of Environmental Quality any unexpended and unencumbered 35 balances appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality for Agri-36 cultural Best Management Practices for fiscal year 2018, in an amount not to 37 exceed \$500,000 from the General Fund, to be used for nonrecurring expendi-38 tures related to agricultural Best Management Practices for the period July 39 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019.
