AN ACT RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR FISCAL 2 YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2021; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIV-4 5 ALENT POSITIONS; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-215, IDAHO CODE, TO INCREASE THE SALARIES OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSIONERS. 6

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Public Utilities Commission the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense classes from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021:

SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Public Utilities Commission is authorized no more than forty-nine (49.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021, unless specifically authorized by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

SECTION 3. That Section 61-215, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

61-215. SALARIES OF PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSIONERS. Each member of the public utilities commission shall devote full time to the performance of his/her duties. Commencing on July 1, 201920, the annual salary of members of the public utilities commission shall be one hundred ten twelve thousand seventy-four two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$\frac{110,074}{112,275}\) and shall be paid from sources set by the legislature.
