RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE LIQUOR DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2 2023; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE STATE LIQUOR DIVISION FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2023; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSI-4 5 TIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 6

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Liquor Division 7 the following amounts to be expended according to the designated expense 8 9 classes from the Liquor Control Fund for the period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023: 10

16 SECTION 2. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the State Liquor Division is authorized no more than two hundred 17 sixty-three (263.00) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the 18 period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, unless specifically authorized 19 by the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be noti-20 fied promptly of any increased positions so authorized. 21

SECTION 3. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 22 declared to exist, this act shall be in full force and effect on and after 23 July 1, 2022. 24
