3 INTENT; AND AMENDING SECTION 39-1392c, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE PROVISIONS
4 RELATING TO IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The Legislature finds that it is 7 important to protect and encourage the free exchange of information and 8 opinions regarding peer review activities, which include credentialing. 9 The Legislature finds that the receiving and use of such information and 10 opinions is synonymous with peer review decisions ultimately made based 11 upon such information and opinions and therefore should be afforded the same 12 treatment and protections.

13 SECTION 2. That Section 39-1392c, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 14 amended to read as follows:

15 39-1392c. IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY. The furnishing of information or provision of opinions to any health care organization or 16 the receiving and use of such information and opinions or actions or peer 17 review decisions based upon the receiving and use of such information and 18 opinions shall not subject any health care organization or other person 19 to any liability or action for money damages or other legal or equitable 20 relief. Custodians of such records and persons becoming aware of such 21 records, data, and opinions, actions or decisions shall not disclose the 22 same except as authorized by rules adopted by the board of medicine or as 23 otherwise authorized by law. Any health care organization may receive 24 such disclosures, subject to an obligation to preserve the confidential 25 privileged character thereof and subject further to the requirement that 26 such requests shall be made and such use shall be limited to aid the health 27 28 care organization in conducting peer review.
