SENATE BILL NO. 1409

BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR  
2 FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE OFFICE OF THE  
3 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS  
4 FOR THE OFFICE OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011;  
5 LIMITING THE NUMBER OF FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN  
6 EMERGENCY.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,  
10 the appropriation to the Office of the State Board of Education made in Sec-  
11 tion 1, Chapter 291, Laws of 2009, is hereby reduced by the following amount  
12 from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010:

13 General Fund \$198,700

14 SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter  
15 291, Laws of 2009, there is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State  
16 Board of Education the following amount to be expended from the listed funds  
17 for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010:

18 Miscellaneous Revenue Fund \$38,600

19 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Board  
20 of Education the following amounts to be expended from the listed funds for  
21 the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011:

22 FROM:

23 General Fund \$2,025,200

24 Indirect Cost Recovery Fund 18,400

25 Miscellaneous Revenue Fund 83,600

26 Federal Grant Fund 1,323,400

27 TOTAL \$3,450,600

1           SECTION 4. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Office  
2 of the State Board of Education is authorized no more than twenty-one and  
3 twenty-five one-hundredths (21.25) full-time equivalent positions at any  
4 point during the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for the program  
5 specified in Section 3 of this act, unless specifically authorized by the  
6 Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified  
7 promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

8           SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
9 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-  
10 fect on and after passage and approval.
