## SENATE BILL NO. 1412

## BY FINANCE COMMITTEE

AN ACT 1 REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2 2010; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICUL-3 TURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF 4 AGRICULTURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED 5 FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; DIRECTING THE STATE CONTROLLER TO 6 TRANSFER FUNDS FROM THE RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INTEGRATED FREIGHT 7 AND TRANSPORTATION FUND TO THE INVASIVE SPECIES FUND; AND DECLARING AN 8 EMERGENCY. 9

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho: 10

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the appropriation made in Section 1, Chapter 268, Laws of 2009, to the 12 Department of Agriculture is hereby reduced by the following amount for the 13 designated programs according to the designated expense classes from the 14 listed fund for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010: 15

SECTION 4. In accordance with Section 67-3519, Idaho Code, the Department of Agriculture is authorized no more than one hundred ninety-four and sixty-eight hundredths (194.68) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011, for the programs specified in Section 3 of this act, unless specifically authorized by the

Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any increased positions so authorized.

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- SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller is hereby directed to transfer \$350,000 from the Rural Economic Development Integrated Freight and Transportation Revolving Loan Account to the Invasive Species Fund on July 1, 2010, or as soon thereafter as possible. Such moneys shall be used for the purpose of managing aquatic weeds.
- 8 SECTION 6. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby 9 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-10 fect on and after passage and approval.
