AN ACT

1 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR FISCAL
2 YEAR 2016; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR
3 FISCAL YEAR 2017; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIV-
4 ALENT POSITIONS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT; AND DECLARING AN EMER-
5 GENCY.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
9 ter 261, Laws of 2015, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there
10 is hereby appropriated from the Invasive Species Fund to the Department of
11 Agriculture, the following amounts to be expended for the designated expense
12 classes, for the period July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2016:

31	SECTION 3. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,				
32	Idaho Code, the Department of Agriculture is authorized no more than two				
33	hundred (200) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the pe-				
34	riod July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, unless specifically authorized by				
35	the Governor. The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified				
36	promptly of any increased positions so authorized.				

1 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that
2 the Department of Agriculture (ISDA) maximize the use of the appropriation
3 provided from the Invasive Species Fund to enhance the boat inspection pro-
4 gram to minimize the chances of spreading zebra and quagga mussels into Idaho
5 waters. Furthermore, it is the intent of the Legislature that ISDA lever-
6 age inspection activities to secure federal funding to the extent possible
7 to further enhance invasive species detection and prevention efforts.

8 SECTION 5. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 4 of this act shall be in full force and ef-
10 fect on and after passage and approval.
