AN ACT

1 RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE  
2 CONSUMER PROTECTION FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020; APPROPRIATING AND TRANS-  
3 FERRING MONEYS FROM THE DRIVER'S TRAINING FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020;  
4 APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME  
5 FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS TO  
6 THE PUBLIC EDUCATION STABILIZATION FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPRO-  
7 PRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS TO THE BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND FOR  
8 FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE STATE  
9 REGULATORY FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING  
10 MONEYS FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING  
11 AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE UNEMPLOYMENT PENALTY AND INTEREST FUND  
12 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE  
13 CORRECTIONAL INDUSTRIES BETTERMENT FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; APPRO-  
14 PRIATING AND TRANSFERRING MONEYS FROM THE PERMANENT BUILDING FUND FOR  
15 FISCAL YEAR 2020; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

18 SECTION 1. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE CONSUMER PROTECTION FUND. Notwith-  
19 standing the provisions of Section 48-606, Idaho Code, and any other provi-  
20 sion of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the State Con-  
21 troller shall transfer \$2,500,000 from the Consumer Protection Fund to the  
22 General Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2019, through June  
23 30, 2020.

24 SECTION 2. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE DRIVER'S TRAINING FUND. Notwith-  
25 standing the provisions of Section 49-308, Idaho Code, and any other  
26 provision of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the State  
27 Controller shall transfer \$3,660,700 from the Driver's Training Fund to the  
28 Public Education Stabilization Fund as soon as practicable for the period  
29 July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

30 SECTION 3. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL INCOME FUND. There is  
31 hereby appropriated and the State Controller shall transfer \$6,259,800 from  
32 the Public School Income Fund to the Public Education Stabilization Fund as  
33 soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

34 SECTION 4. CASH TRANSFER TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION STABILIZATION FUND.  
35 There is hereby appropriated and the State Controller shall transfer  
36 \$21,079,500 from the General Fund to the Public Education Stabilization Fund  
37 on July 1, 2020, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1,  
38 2020, through June 30, 2021.

1 SECTION 5. CASH TRANSFER TO THE BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND. Notwith-  
2 standing the provisions of Section 57-814(2) (b), Idaho Code, which limits  
3 the allowable balance in the Budget Stabilization Fund to ten percent (10%)  
4 of total General Fund receipts for the fiscal year just ending, and Section  
5 57-814(2) (c), Idaho Code, which requires the State Controller to transfer  
6 excess moneys in the Budget Stabilization Fund back to the General Fund, and  
7 any other provision of law to the contrary, on July 1, 2020, or as soon there-  
8 after as practicable, there is hereby appropriated and the State Controller  
9 shall transfer \$30,000,000 from the General Fund to the Budget Stabilization  
10 Fund established in Section 57-814, Idaho Code, for the period July 1, 2020,  
11 through June 30, 2021.

12 SECTION 6. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE STATE REGULATORY FUND. Notwithstand-  
13 ing the provisions of Section 54-1720, Idaho Code, and any other provision  
14 of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the State Controller  
15 shall transfer \$117,500 from the State Regulatory Fund to the General Fund  
16 on July 1, 2020, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1,  
17 2020, through June 30, 2021.

18 SECTION 7. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY FUND. Notwithstanding  
19 the provisions of Section 40-705, Idaho Code, and any other provision of law  
20 to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the State Controller shall  
21 transfer \$108,900 from the State Highway Fund to the General Fund on July  
22 1, 2020, or as soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2020,  
23 through June 30, 2021.

24 SECTION 8. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE UNEMPLOYMENT PENALTY AND INTEREST  
25 FUND. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 72-1348, Idaho Code, and any  
26 other provision of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the  
27 State Controller shall transfer \$108,900 from the Unemployment Penalty and  
28 Interest Fund to the General Fund on July 1, 2020, or as soon thereafter as  
29 practicable for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021.

30 SECTION 9. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE CORRECTIONAL INDUSTRIES BETTERMENT  
31 FUND. Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 20-416 and 20-419, Idaho  
32 Code, and any other provision of law to the contrary, there is hereby appro-  
33 priated and the State Controller shall transfer \$250,000 from the Correc-  
34 tional Industries Betterment Fund to the General Fund on July 1, 2020, or as  
35 soon thereafter as practicable for the period July 1, 2020, through June 30,  
36 2021.

37 SECTION 10. CASH TRANSFER FROM THE PERMANENT BUILDING FUND. Notwith-  
38 standing the provisions of Section 57-1108, Idaho Code, and any other provi-  
39 sion of law to the contrary, there is hereby appropriated and the State Con-  
40 troller shall transfer \$8,800,000 from the Permanent Building Fund to the  
41 General Fund as soon as practicable for the period July 1, 2019, through June  
42 30, 2020.

1           SECTION 11. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby  
2 declared to exist, Sections 1, 2, 3, and 10 of this act shall be in full force  
3 and effect on and after passage and approval.
