SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 113

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE DOCKET OF  
THE IDAHO STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING  
LIVESTOCK DEALERS, BUYING STATIONS, AND LIVESTOCK TRADER LOTS.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
islative intent; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule docket  
of the Idaho State Department of Agriculture relating to Rules Governing  
Livestock Dealers, Buying Stations, and Livestock Trader Lots is not consis-  
tent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular  
Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of  
Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 02.04.28, the Idaho State  
Department of Agriculture, Rules Governing Livestock Dealers, Buying Sta-  
tions, and Livestock Trader Lots, adopted as a pending rule under Docket  
Number 02-0428-1401, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is  
hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
