2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DI-  
3 VISION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING PLUMBING SAFETY  
4 LICENSING.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with  
9 legislative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the  
11 Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Governing Plumbing Safety Li-  
12 censing is not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular  
14 Session of the Sixtieth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of  
15 Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.02.05, Rules Governing  
16 Plumbing Safety Licensing, Rules of the Division of Building Safety, adopted  
17 as a pending rule under Docket Number 07-0205-0901, the entire rulemaking  
18 docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no  
19 force and effect.
