A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING PENDING RULES THAT IMPOSE
3 A FEE OR CHARGE REVIEWED BY THE SENATE RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENT COMMIT-
4 TEE AND THE HOUSE ENVIRONMENT, ENERGY, AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature pursuant to Section 67-5224, Idaho Code, must
7 approve certain administrative rules that impose a fee or charge by adoption
8 of a concurrent resolution before the rules become effective; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
10 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
11 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
12 islative intent; and

13 WHEREAS, the Senate Resources and Environment Committee and the House
14 Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee reviewed rules that impose a
15 fee or charge adopted by the Department of Environmental Quality as set forth
16 in Docket No. 58-0000-2100F; and

17 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
18 adopt this resolution.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
20 sion of the Sixty-sixth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
21 sentatives concurring therein, that pending fee rules adopted by the Depart-
22 ment of Environmental Quality, as set forth in Docket No. 58-0000-2100F,
23 pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act and submitted through the Of-
24 fice of Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2022 leg-
25 islative session and reviewed by the Senate Resources and Environment Com-
26 mittee and the House Environment, Energy, and Technology Committee, be, and
27 the same are hereby approved.
