SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 129

BY JUDICIARY AND RULES COMMITTEE

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND APPROVING PENDING RULES OF THE
3 DIVISION OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND PERSONNEL COMMISSION, THE IDAHO INDUS-
4 TRIAL COMMISSION, AND THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF IDAHO
5 REVIEWED BY THE SENATE COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AND THE
6 HOUSE COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE, WITH EXCEPTIONS.

7 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, the Legislature must
9 approve pending administrative rules by adoption of a concurrent resolu-
10 tion; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, any
12 pending rule that is not approved by adoption of a concurrent resolution
13 shall expire upon adjournment sine die of the legislative session during
14 which the agency submits the pending rule to the Legislature for review; and

15 WHEREAS, the Senate Commerce and Human Resources Committee and the
16 House Commerce and Human Resources Committee reviewed pending rules adopted
17 by the Division of Human Resources and Personnel Commission, the Idaho In-
18 dustrial Commission, and the Public Employees Retirement System of Idaho;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
21 Idaho Industrial Commission, Administrative Rules Under the Crime Victims
22 Compensation Act, are not consistent with legislative intent; and

23 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that it is in the public interest to
24 adopt this resolution.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
26 sion of the Sixty-seventh Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
27 resentatives concurring therein, that the pending rules adopted by the Divi-
28 sion of Human Resources and Personnel Commission, the Idaho Industrial Com-
29 mission, and the Public Employees Retirement System of Idaho, pursuant to
30 the Administrative Procedure Act and submitted through the Office of the Ad-
31 ministrative Rules Coordinator to the Legislature for review during the 2024
32 legislative session and reviewed by the Senate Commerce and Human Resources
33 Committee and the House Commerce and Human Resources Committee, be, and the
34 same are hereby approved with the exception of IDAPA 17.10.01, Administra-
35 tive Rules Under the Crime Victims Compensation Act, Docket No. 17-1001-
36 2301, Section 011., Subsection 07., and Section 013., Subsection 02., only.
