1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DIVI-
3	SION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING SAFETY INSPECTIONS.
4	Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
5	WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
6	agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
7	event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
8	islative intent; and
9	WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
10	Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Governing Safety Inspections
11	are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.
12	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular
13	Session of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of
14	Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.04.01, relating to Rules
15	Governing Safety Inspections, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number
16 17	07-0401-1701, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
