## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 103

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF 2 IDAHO, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 23, ARTICLE I, TO PROVIDE THAT 3 4 HUNTING, FISHING AND TRAPPING ARE A VALUED PART OF THE HERITAGE OF THE STATE OF IDAHO AND SHALL FOREVER BE PRESERVED FOR THE PEOPLE, TO PROVIDE 5 THAT THE EXERCISE OF THIS RIGHT BY THE PEOPLE SHALL NOT BE PROHIBITED BUT 6 SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE LAWS, RULES AND PROCLAMATIONS OF THE STATE AND 7 TO PROVIDE THAT THE RIGHTS SET FORTH DO NOT CREATE A RIGHT TO TRESPASS 8 ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, SHALL NOT AFFECT RIGHTS TO DIVERT, APPROPRIATE AND 9 USE WATER, AND SHALL NOT LEAD TO A DIMINUTION OF OTHER PRIVATE RIGHTS; 10 STATING THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE; DIRECTING THE 11 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DI-12 RECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND ARGUMENTS AS 13 REQUIRED BY LAW. 14

15 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Article I, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho, be, and the same is hereby amended by the addition thereto of a <u>NEW SECTION</u>, to be known and designated as Section 23, Article I, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho and to read as follows:

SECTION 23. RIGHT TO HUNT, FISH AND TRAP. Hunting, fishing 20 and trapping are a valued part of the heritage of the State of Idaho 21 22 and shall forever be preserved for the people. The exercise of this 23 right by the people shall not be prohibited but shall be subject to the laws, rules and proclamations of the state. The rights set 24 forth herein do not create a right to trespass on private property, 25 shall not affect rights to divert, appropriate and use water, and 26 shall not lead to a diminution of other private rights. 27

28 SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of29 Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:

"Shall Article I, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended by 30 the addition of a New Section 23, to provide that hunting, fishing and trap-31 ping are a valued part of the heritage of the State of Idaho and shall for-32 ever be preserved for the people; to provide that the exercise of this right 33 by the people shall not be prohibited but shall be subject to the laws, rules 34 and proclamations of the state; and to provide that the rights set forth do 35 36 not create a right to trespass on private property, shall not affect rights to divert, appropriate and use water, and shall not lead to a diminution of 37 other private rights?". 38

39 SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the state-40 ments required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same. SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this
proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
