1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated for the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
9 Governor:

5 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Governor's Grant
7 Fund to the Office of the Governor to be expended in
8 accordance with the terms and conditions upon which such
9 funds were received and in the exercise of the powers or
10 performance of the duties of the Office of the Governor.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
12 2011.
