Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
7 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund to meet its  
8 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024.

9 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof  
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
11 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the  
12 following purpose:

13 To support outreach, research, and  
14 training activities .....7,000,000

15 Section 15. The sum of \$401,566,200, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
17 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant  
18 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program, as  
19 provided by law, and for agency administrative and operational  
20 costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in

1 this Section.

2 Section 20. The sum of \$300,000,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
4 Assistance Commission from the Education Assistance Fund for  
5 grant awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award  
6 Program, as provided by law, and for agency administrative and  
7 operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total  
8 appropriation in this Section.

9 Section 25. The sum of \$35,000,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
11 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for  
12 payments to eligible public universities for grants to students  
13 pursuant to the AIM HIGH program.

14 Section 30. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may  
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
16 the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs associated  
17 with providing grants to exonerated persons, as provided by  
18 law.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$26,400, or so much thereof as may  
20 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
21 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs

1 associated with the Veterans' Home Medical Providers' Loan  
2 Repayment Program pursuant to Public Act 99-0813.

3 Section 40. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
5 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for grants  
6 to eligible nurse educators to use for payment of their  
7 educational loan pursuant to Public Act 94-1020.

8 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the  
10 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
11 Commission for the following purposes:

12 Grants and Scholarships

13	For the payment of scholarships to students	
14	who are children of police officers or firefighters	
15	killed in the line of duty, or who are	
16	dependents of correctional officers killed	
17	or permanently disabled in the line of	
18	duty, as provided by law .....	1,300,000
19	For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships .....	<u>7,000,000</u>
20	Total	\$8,300,000

21 Section 50. The sum of \$6,498,000, or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance

1 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission to the  
2 Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois program, as provided by law.

3 Section 55. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
5 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission to the  
6 Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois program for the Golden Apple  
7 Accelerators Program.

8 Section 60. The sum of \$975,000, or so much thereof as may  
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
10 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the Loan  
11 Repayment for Teachers Program.

12  
13 Section 65. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may  
14 be necessary, is appropriated from the ISAC Accounts Receivable  
15 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs  
16 associated with the collection of delinquent scholarship awards  
17 pursuant to the Illinois State Collection Act of 1986.

18 Section 70. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as may  
19 be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
20 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for  
21 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate  
22 Program, as provided by law.

1 Section 75. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Student  
 3 Assistance Commission Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois  
 4 Student Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

5 To support outreach, research, and  
 6 training activities .....5,000,000  
 7 Community Behavioral Health Care  
 8 Provider Loan Repayment Program .....5,000,000

9 Section 80. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Optometric  
 11 Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the Illinois Student  
 12 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

13 Grants and Scholarships  
 14 For payment of scholarships for the  
 15 Optometric Education Scholarship  
 16 Program, as provided by law .....50,000

17 Section 85. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the National Guard  
 19 and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 20 Commission for the following purpose:

21 Grants and Scholarships  
 22 For payment of Illinois National Guard and

1 Naval Militia Scholarships  
 2 at State-controlled universities  
 3 and public community colleges in  
 4 Illinois to students eligible to  
 5 receive such awards, as provided by law .....20,000

6 Section 90. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may  
 7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Golden Apple Scholars  
 8 of Illinois Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
 9 for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program, as provided  
 10 by law.

11 Section 95. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 12 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
 13 Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the Student Loan  
 14 Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent expenses:

15 For Administration  
 16 For Personal Services .....13,538,600  
 17 For State Contributions to State  
 18 Employees Retirement System .....7,312,600  
 19 For State Contributions to  
 20 Social Security .....1,029,000  
 21 For State Contributions for  
 22 Employees Group Insurance .....5,436,800  
 23 For Contractual Services .....10,000,000

1	For Travel .....	311,000
2	For Commodities .....	282,200
3	For Printing .....	501,000
4	For Equipment .....	540,000
5	For Telecommunications .....	1,897,900

8 Section 100. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as  
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
 10 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund for  
 11 costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and  
 12 Maintenance.

13 Section 105. The sum of \$1,000,000 or so much thereof as  
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student  
 15 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund for  
 16 costs associated with the Illinois Designated Account Purchase  
 17 Program.

 19 Section 110. The following named sum, or so much thereof  
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal  
 21 Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program Fund to the Illinois  
 22 Student Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

23 For transferring repayment funds collected



1       under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship  
 2       Program to the U.S. Treasury .....100,000

3       Section 115. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof  
 4       as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
 5       Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for  
 6       distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for  
 7       guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection  
 8       payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under  
 9       agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for  
 10      payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default Aversion  
 11      Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for other  
 12      distributions as necessary and provided for under the Federal  
 13      Higher Education Act.

14      Section 120. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof  
 15      as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student  
 16      Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
 17      Commission for allowable uses of federal grant funds related  
 18      to college access, outreach, and training, including but not  
 19      limited to funds received under the federal Gaining Early  
 20      Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program.

21      Section 125. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
 22      may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student

1 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
2 Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment  
3 Program.

4 Section 130. The sum of \$114,000,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Student Loan  
6 Operating Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
7 for financial assistance and administrative costs associated  
8 with early childhood programs.

9 Section 135. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nursing Dedicated  
11 and Professional Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance  
12 Commission for expenses related to the Nursing Education  
13 Scholarship Law.

14 Section 140. The sum of \$1,100,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Energy Transition  
16 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission  
17 for costs associated with providing grants to eligible  
18 individuals, for costs pursuant to the Energy Transition Act.

19 Section 145. The sum of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof as  
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
21 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs

1 associated with Social Worker Scholarships and loan repayment  
2 assistance.

3 ARTICLE 2

4 Section 5. The sum of \$3,280,045, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business  
6 on June 30, 2023, from an appropriation heretofore made for  
7 such purpose in Article 138, Section 400 of Public Act 102-  
8 0698, as amended, is reappropriated from the State Coronavirus  
9 Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Illinois Student  
10 Assistance Commission for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois  
11 Program, for purposes permitted by Section 9901 of the American  
12 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and related federal guidance.

13 Section 10. The sum of \$3,492,690, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business  
15 on June 30, 2023, from an appropriation heretofore made for  
16 such purpose in Article 138, Section 405 of Public Act 102-  
17 0698, as amended, is reappropriated from the State Coronavirus  
18 Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Illinois Student  
19 Assistance Commission for the Golden Apple Accelerators  
20 Program, for purposes permitted by Section 9901 of the American  
21 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and related federal guidance.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
2    2023.
