 8 facilities under the jurisdiction of the Office of the
 9 Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and
 10 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental
 11 to the above work:

13 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
 15 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
 16 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the

6 Section 85. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
 7 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
 8 the Office of the Secretary of State for all expenditures and
 9 grants to libraries for the Project Next Generation Program.

10 Section 90. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
 12 Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the
 13 purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

15 Section 95. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State

 20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the

2 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention
3 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-
4 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model
5 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in
6 Illinois.

7 Section 105. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
9 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants
10 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American
11 fraternities and sororities.

12 Section 110. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
14 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants
15 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
16 Programming.

17 Section 115. The sum of \$170,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
19 from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide
20 grants for the development of tourism, education,
21 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

1 Section 120. The sum of \$175,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police Memorial
 3 Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
 4 grants to the Police Memorial Committee for maintaining a
 5 memorial statue, holding an annual memorial commemoration,
 6 and giving scholarships to children of police officers killed
 7 in the line of duty.

8 Section 125. The sum of \$130,000, or so much thereof as
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mammogram Fund to
 10 the Office of the Secretary of State for grants to the Susan
 11 G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer research, education,
 12 screening, and treatment.

13 Section 130. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 14 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 15 Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in Section
 16 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for grants
 17 to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-America
 18 Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of organ and
 19 tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in addition to
 20 any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office of the
 21 Secretary of State:

22 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund170,000

1 Section 135. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
3 from the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund for grants
4 to the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation for maintenance of
5 a memorial and park, holding an annual memorial
6 commemoration, giving scholarships to children of police
7 officers killed or catastrophically injured in the line of
8 duty, providing financial assistance to police officers and
9 their families when a police officer is killed or injured in
10 the line of duty, and paying the insurance premiums for
11 police officers who are terminally ill.

12 Section 140. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
14 from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants
15 for scholarships for Higher Education.

16 Section 145. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS Federal
18 Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the
19 payment of any operational expenses relating to the cost
20 incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle
21 safety program by assuring and verifying the identity of
22 drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for
23 improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal

1 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed
2 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

3 Section 150. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
5 Secretary of State from the Securities Investors Education
6 Fund for any expenses used to promote public awareness of the
7 dangers of securities fraud.

8 Section 155. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
10 of State from the Secretary of State Evidence Fund for the
11 purchase of evidence, for the employment of persons to obtain
12 evidence, and for the payment for any goods or services
13 related to obtaining evidence.

14 Section 160. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels
16 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of
17 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

18 Section 165. The sum of \$17,074,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
20 State Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
21 State for office automation and technology.

1 Section 170. The sum of \$14,640,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor Vehicle
3 License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State
4 for the cost incident to providing new or replacement plates
5 for motor vehicles.

6 Section 175. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
8 DUI Administration Fund to the Office of Secretary of State
9 for operation of the Department of Administrative Hearings of
10 the Office of Secretary of State and for no other purpose.

11 Section 180. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
13 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of
14 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of
15 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

16 Section 185. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
18 Police Services Fund to the Secretary of State for purposes
19 as indicated by the grantor or contractor or, in the case of
20 money bequeathed or granted for no specific purpose, for any
21 purpose as deemed appropriate by the Director of Police,

1 Secretary of State in administering the responsibilities of
2 the Secretary of State Department of Police.

3 Section 190. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office of the
5 Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the Secretary
6 of State to be expended in accordance with the terms and
7 conditions upon which such funds were received.

8 Section 195. The sum of \$24,300, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
10 Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to increase
11 the collection of books, records, and holdings; to hold
12 public forums; to purchase equipment and resource materials
13 for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair, and
14 maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

15 Section 200. The following sum, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
17 of State for any operations, alterations, rehabilitations,
18 new construction, and maintenance of the interior and
19 exterior of the various buildings and facilities under the
20 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance security
21 measures in the Capitol Complex:

22 From General Revenue Fund3,700,000

1 Section 205. The sum of \$13,500,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
3 State Identification Security and Theft Prevention Fund to
4 the Office of Secretary of State for all costs related to
5 implementing identification security and theft prevention
6 measures.

7 Section 210. The sum of \$2,600,000, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
9 Secretary of State from the Driver Services Administration
10 Fund for the payment of costs related to the issuance of
11 temporary visitor's driver's licenses, and other operational
12 costs, including personnel, facilities, computer programming,
13 and data transmission.

14 Section 215. The sum of \$2,350,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Monitoring Device
16 Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to the Office of the
17 Secretary of State for all Secretary of State costs
18 associated with administering Monitoring Device Driving
19 Permits per Public Act 95-0400.

20 Section 220. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent BAIID

1 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to reimburse
2 ignition interlock device providers per Public Act 95-0400.

3 Section 225. The sum of \$55,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
5 from the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior
6 Golf Fund for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers
7 Association Foundation to help Association members expose
8 Illinois youngsters to the game of golf.

9 Section 230. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
11 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to
12 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public
13 and private schools within Illinois.

14 Section 235. The sum of \$40,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
16 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the
17 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl
18 Scouts of the U.S.A.

19 Section 240. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
21 from the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois

1 Support Our Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the
2 troops and their families in accordance with its Articles of
3 Incorporation.

4 Section 245. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the
6 Illinois EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training Fund for
7 grants to the EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training Council
8 for providing scholarships for graduate study, undergraduate
9 study, or both, to children and spouses of emergency medical
10 services (EMS) personnel killed in the course of their
11 employment and for grants for the training of EMS personnel.

12 Section 250. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
14 Secretary of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants for
15 charitable purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

16 Section 255. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
18 Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund for
19 grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for
20 ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment.

21 Section 260. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
2 Secretary of State from the Sheet Metal Workers International
3 Association of Illinois Fund for grants for charitable
4 purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the Sheet Metal
5 Workers International Association.

6 Section 265. The sum of \$90,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
8 Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund
9 for providing death benefits for the families of police
10 officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing
11 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or
12 both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in
13 the line of duty.

14 Section 270. The sum of \$35,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
16 from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for
17 grants to the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for
18 religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational
19 purposes.

20 Section 275. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
21 necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
22 State from the 4-H Fund for grants to the Illinois 4-H

1 foundation for the purpose of funding 4-H programs in
2 Illinois.

3 Section 280. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
5 Secretary of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund
6 for grants to the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to
7 increase the efficiency and professionalism of law
8 enforcement officers in Illinois, to educate the public about
9 law enforcement issues, to more firmly establish the public
10 confidence in law enforcement, to create partnerships with
11 the public, and to honor the service of law enforcement
12 officers.

13 Section 285. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
15 from the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of
16 Illinois Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for
17 educational programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how
18 to legally and more safely share the roadways.

19 Section 290. The sum of \$3,500, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
21 Secretary of State from the St. Jude Children's Research Fund
22 for grants to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for

1 pediatric treatment and research.

2 Section 295. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
4 Secretary of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants
5 to Ducks Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection,
6 enhancement, and restoration projects in the State of
7 Illinois, to fund education and outreach for media,
8 volunteers, members, and the general public regarding
9 waterfowl and wetlands conservation in the State of Illinois,
10 and to cover reasonable cost for Ducks Unlimited plate
11 advertising and administration of the wetland conservation
12 projects and education program.

13 Section 300. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
15 from the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated
16 with enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

17 Section 305. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
18 necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
19 State from the Soil and Water Conservation District Fund for
20 grants to Illinois soil and water conservation districts for
21 projects that conserve and restore soil and water in
22 Illinois.

1 Section 310. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund
4 for grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation,
5 Inc. for building and maintaining a memorial and park,
6 holding an annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships
7 to children of State police officers killed or
8 catastrophically injured in the line of duty, and providing
9 financial assistance to police officers and their families
10 when a police officer is killed or injured in the line of
11 duty.

12 Section 315. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship
15 and Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs'
16 Association for scholarships obtained in a competitive
17 process to attend the Illinois Teen Institute or an
18 accredited college or university, for programs designed to
19 benefit the elderly and teens, and for law enforcement
20 training.
