SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$40,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Arts Council to distribute grants for arts-based after school programs in communities that are in areas that are 125% above the poverty level according to the United States Census Bureau. Effective July 1, 2017.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Arts Council to distribute grants for arts-based after school programs in communities that are in areas that are 125% above the poverty level according to the United States Census Bureau.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
