1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3794

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3794, by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary for statewide purposes, is appropriated  
7 from the Transportation Bond Series D Fund to the Department  
8 of Transportation for preliminary engineering and  
9 construction engineering and contract costs of construction,  
10 including reconstruction, extension and improvement of state  
11 and local highways, arterial highways, roads, access areas,  
12 roadside shelters, rest areas, and fringe parking facilities  
13 and sanitary facilities, and such other purposes as provided  
14 by the "Illinois Highway Code"; for purposes allowed or

1 required by Title 23 of the U.S. Code; for bikeways as  
 2 provided by Public Act 78-850; for land acquisition and  
 3 signboard removal and control and preservation of natural  
 4 beauty; and for capital improvements which directly  
 5 facilitate an effective vehicle weight enforcement program,  
 6 such as scales (fixed and portable), scale pits and scale  
 7 installations and scale houses, in accordance with applicable  
 8 laws and regulations for the state and local portions of the  
 9 Road Improvement Program.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof  
 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation  
 12 Bond Series D Fund to the Department of Transportation for  
 13 grants to counties, municipalities, and road districts for  
 14 planning, engineering, acquisition, construction,  
 15 reconstruction, development, improvement, extension, and all  
 16 construction related expenses of the public infrastructure  
 17 and other transportation improvement projects which are  
 18 related to economic development in the State of Illinois  
 19 allocated as follows:

20	For the municipalities of the State .....	49,100,000
21	For the counties of the State having	
22	1,000,000 or more inhabitants .....	16,740,000
23	For the counties of the State having less	
24	than 1,000,000 inhabitants .....	18,270,000

1	For the road districts of the State .....	<u>15,890,000</u>
2	Total	\$100,000,000

3 ARTICLE 99

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
5 1, 2014."
