SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes specified appropriations and reappropriations to the General Assembly and the Legislative Ethics Commission for their ordinary and contingent expenses of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017. Effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President
6 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
7 for furnishing the items provided in Section 4 of the General
8 Assembly Compensation Act to members of their respective houses
9 throughout the year in connection with their legislative duties
10 and responsibilities and not in connection with any political
11 campaign as prescribed by law. Of this amount, 37.436% is
12 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures
13 and 62.564% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
14 expenditures.

15 Section 10. Payments from the sums appropriated in Section
16 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher
17 approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher
18 shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the
19 Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case may be.

20 Section 15. The sum of \$20,603,400, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet the

1 ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate legislative
2 leadership and legislative staff assistants and the House
3 Majority and Minority leadership staff, general staff and office
4 operations. Of this amount, 25.7% is appropriated to the
5 President of the Senate for such expenditures, 25.7% is
6 appropriated to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures
7 and 24.8% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
8 expenditures, and 23.8% is appropriated to the House Minority
9 Leader for such expenditures.

10 Section 20. The sum of \$9,882,100, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President
12 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
13 for the ordinary and incidental expenses of committees, the
14 general staff and operations, per diem employees, special and
15 standing committees, expenses incurred in transcribing and
16 printing of debates. Of this amount, 43.018% is appropriated to
17 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is
18 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

19 Section 25. The sum of \$309,200, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of
21 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for
22 the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the
23 purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding,

1 printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House,
2 no part of which shall be expended for expenses of purchasing,
3 handling or distributing such supplies and against which no
4 indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of
5 the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount,
6 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
7 expenditures and 30.723% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
8 House for such expenditures.

9 Section 30. The sum of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President
11 of the Senate for the use of standing committees for expert
12 witnesses, technical services, consulting assistance and other
13 research assistance associated with special studies and long
14 range research projects which may be requested by the standing
15 committees and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for
16 Standing House Committees pursuant to the Legislative Commission
17 Reorganization Act of 1984. Of this amount, 46.862% is
18 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures
19 and 53.138% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
20 expenditures.

21 Section 35. The sum of \$167,000, or so much thereof as may
22 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of
23 the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for allowances for the

1 particular and additional services appertaining to or entailed
2 by the respective officers of the Senate. Of this amount, 50%
3 is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
4 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Senate Minority
5 Leader for such expenditures.

6 Section 40. The sum of \$88,100, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of
8 the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for
9 travel, including expenses to Springfield of members on official
10 legislative business during weeks when the General Assembly is
11 not in Session. Of this amount, 65.5% is appropriated to the
12 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 34.5% is
13 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

14 Section 45. The sum of \$341,600, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
16 the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent expenses.
17 Any use of funds appropriated under this Section must be approved
18 jointly by the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
19 Secretary of the Senate.

20 Section 50. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where the
21 approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives is
22 expressly required for the expenditure of or the incurring of

1 indebtedness against an appropriation for certain purchases on
2 contract, "Speaker" means the leader of the party having the
3 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as of
4 January 11, 2017, and "Minority Leader" means the leader of the
5 party having the second largest number of members of the House
6 of Representatives as of January 11, 2017.

7 Section 55. The sum of \$312,500, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics
9 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
10 Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector General.

11 Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent
13 expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the
14 planning costs, construction costs, moving expenses and all other
15 costs associated with the construction and reconstruction of
16 Senate offices in the Capitol Complex area.

17 Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General
19 Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President of the Senate
20 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to meet ordinary
21 and contingent expenses. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to
22 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is

1 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

2 Section 70. The following named sums, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an appropriation
4 hereto made for such purposes in Section 70 of Article 21 of
5 Public Act 98-0679, as amended, are re-appropriated from the
6 General Revenue Fund for expenses in connection with the planning
7 and preparation of redistricting of Legislative and
8 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of
9 the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

10	To the Senate President	500,000
11	To the Senate Minority Leader	<u>500,000</u>
12	Total	\$1,000,000

13 Section 75. The following named sums, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an appropriation
15 hereto made for such purposes in Section 75 of Article 21 of
16 Public Act 98-0679, as amended, are re-appropriated from the
17 General Revenue Fund for expenses in connection with the planning
18 and preparation of redistricting of Legislative and
19 Representative Districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of
20 the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

21	To the House Speaker	500,000
22	To the House Minority Leader	<u>500,000</u>
23	Total	\$1,000,000

1 Section 80. The sum of \$441,600, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation
3 heretofore made for such purposes in Section 80 of Article 21
4 of Public Act 98-0679, as amended, is reappropriated to the
5 Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the
6 planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and
7 representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3
8 of the Illinois Constitution on 1970.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
10 2017.
