A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5 as are available for distribution in accordance with Section 8
6 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law, are appropriated from the Motor Fuel
7 Tax Fund to the Department of Transportation for the purposes
8 stated:

9 DISTRIBUTIVE ITEMS

10 For apportioning, allotting, and paying
11 as provided by law:

12	To Counties.....	204,108,000
13	To Municipalities.....	285,775,000
14	To Counties for Distribution to	
15	Road Districts.....	<u>92,617,000</u>
16	Total	\$582,500,000

17 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund
19 to the Illinois Gaming Board for distributions to local
20 governments for admissions and wagering tax, including prior
21 year costs.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Lottery
3 Fund to the Department of the Lottery for payment of prizes to
4 holders of winning lottery tickets or shares, including prizes
5 related to Multi-State Lottery games, and payment of
6 promotional or incentive prizes associated with the sale of
7 lottery tickets, pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois
8 Lottery Law.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
11 Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless Service
12 Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the Statewide 911
13 Administrator Program.

14 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000,000, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1
16 Fund to the Department of State Police for costs pursuant to
17 the Emergency Telephone System Act.

18 Section 30. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service
20 Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for its
21 administrative costs and for grants to emergency telephone
22 system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department

1 of State Police for the design, implementation, operation,
2 maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency
3 services and public safety answering points.

4 Section 35. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
6 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and
7 contingent expenses of the Department of Revenue:

8 GOVERNMENT SERVICES

9 PAYABLE FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT VIDEO GAMING

10 DISTRIBUTIVE FUND

11 For allocation to local governments
12 of the net terminal income tax per
13 the Video Gaming Act.....45,000,000

14 Section 40. The following named sums, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of
16 Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:

17 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROMOTION

18 Payable from the Multiple Sclerosis Research Fund:
19 For grants to conduct Multiple
20 Sclerosis research.....3,000,000

21 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof
22 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of

1 Public Health for expenses of programs related to Acquired
2 Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS) and Human Immunodeficiency
3 Virus (HIV):

4 OFFICE OF HEALTH PROTECTION: AIDS/HIV

5 Payable from the Quality of Life Endowment Fund:

6 For grants and expenses associated

7 with HIV/AIDS prevention and education.....2,000,000

8 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department
10 of Public Health for the objects and purposes hereinafter
11 named:

12 OFFICE OF WOMEN'S HEALTH

13 Payable from the Carolyn Adams Ticket

14 for the Cure Grant Fund:

15 For Grants and related expenses to

16 public or private entities in Illinois

17 for the purpose of funding research

18 concerning breast cancer and for

19 funding services for breast cancer victims.....2,500,000

20 Section 55. The following named sums, or so much thereof
21 as may be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter
22 named, are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for
23 Grants-In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions

1 pursuant to Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and
2 the Community Mental Health Act:

3 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES GRANTS AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

4 GRANTS-IN-AID AND PURCHASED CARE

5 Payable from Special Olympics Illinois and

6 Special Children's Charities Fund:

7 For grants to Special Olympics

8 Illinois and Special Children's Charities.....700,000

9 Section 60. The sum of \$8,300,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Veterans
11 Assistance Fund to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for
12 making grants, funding additional services, or conducting
13 additional research projects relating to veterans' post
14 traumatic stress disorder; veterans' homelessness; the health
15 insurance cost of veterans; veterans' disability benefits,
16 including but not limited to, disability benefits provided by
17 veterans service organizations and veterans assistance
18 commissions or centers; and the long-term care of veterans.

19 Section 65. The following named amounts, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
21 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the IMSA
22 Income Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to
23 meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year

1 ending June 30, 2016:

14 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this
 15 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
 16 June 30, 2016.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
 18 becoming law.
