1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
7 to the Human Rights Commission for the objects and purposes  
8 hereinafter enumerated:

10 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

11	For Personal Services .....	1,676,000
12	For State Contributions to State

1           Section 10. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
2           as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Special  
3           Projects Division Fund to the Human Rights Commission for  
4           costs associated with processing and adjudicating cases under  
5           Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and U.S. Department  
6           of Housing and Urban Development contracts.

7           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
8           2009.
