1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 Section 1. The sum of \$9,918,900, or so much thereof as 5 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 7 to the Department of Human Rights for operational expenses of 8 the Department. Section 5. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may 9 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human Rights Training and Development Fund to the Department of Human 11 12 Rights for the purpose of funding expenses associated with 13 administration. Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof 14 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 15 16 Special Projects Division Fund: 17 18 For State Contributions to State 19 For State Contributions to Social Security181,900 20

- Section 15. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may 9 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human Rights Special Fund to the Department of Human Rights for the 11 12 purpose of filing expenses associated with the Department of Human Rights. 13
- Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 14 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 15 16 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 17 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
