AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

The sum of \$1,700,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business 22 on June 30, 2024, from an appropriation heretofore made for 23 such purpose in Article 108, Section 1 of Public Act 103-0006, 24 as amended, is reappropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to HB5744 -3- OMB103 00371 JMW 45371 b 1 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for Electronic Data 2 Processing.

3 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 5 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses 6 related to or in support of the Fire Explorer and Cadet School.

Section 15. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants for the
Small Equipment Grant Program.

11 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 13 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated 14 with the Minimum Basic Firefighter Training Program.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 17 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated 18 with the Illinois Firefighter Peer Support Program.

Section 30. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as may
 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to

3 Section 35. The sum of \$380,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 5 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated 6 with the Firefighter Online Training Management System.

7 Section 40. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business 9 on June 30, 2024, from an appropriation heretofore made for 10 such purpose in Article 108, Section 35 of Public Act 103-0006, 11 as amended, is reappropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 12 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated with the renovation and rehabilitation of the Fire Museum 13 14 Building located on the State Fairgrounds in Springfield.

15 Section 45. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Fire Fighters' 17 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 18 expenses related to the Maintenance and Rehabilitation of the 19 Fire Museum Building and Museum Artifacts.

20 Section 50. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may 21 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Fire Fighters'

Section 65. The sum of \$500, or so much thereof as may be
necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the
Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for the
development of new fire districts.

Section 70. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS administration.

15 Section 75. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 17 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the 18 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Reimbursement.

Section 80. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the HB5744 -7- OMB103 00371 JMW 45371 b 1 City of Chicago for administrative costs incurred as a result 2 of the State's Underground Storage Tank Program.

3 Section 85. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 5 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for Diversity, Equity and 6 Inclusion curriculum development for fire service training.

Section 90. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may
be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to
the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the Illinois
Fire Service Institute for research activities.

11 Section 95. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 13 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the Fire Station 14 Rehabilitation and Construction Grant Program.

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Section 100. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for all costs associated with Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion outreach activities.
