SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$24,342,458 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for its ordinance and contingent expenses. Appropriates \$178,000 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program. Appropriates \$400,000 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender Resource Center. Appropriates \$70,000 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide training to public defenders under the Public Defender Training Program. Effective July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
6 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of
8 the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services	\$18,789,942
10	For State Contributions to Social Security	1,437,430
11	For Contractual Services	2,929,286
12	For Travel	43,800
13	For Commodities	27,000
14	For Printing	28,000
15	For Equipment	54,000
16	For EDP	990,000
17	For Telecommunications	43,000
18	Total	\$24,342,458

19 Section 10. The amount of \$178,000, or so much of that
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
21 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for
22 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement

1 Program.

2 Section 15. The amount \$70,000, or so much of that amount as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
4 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide
5 statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public
6 Defender Training Program.

7 Section 20. The amount of \$400,000, or so much of that amount
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund
9 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a
10 Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
12 2020.
