Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1-5. The sum of \$21,636,700, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated to meet the ordinary and 7 contingent expenses of the Office of the State Comptroller.

8 Section 1-10. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller 10 from the Comptroller's Administrative Fund for the discharge 11 of duties of the office.

Section 1-15. The sum of \$50,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller from the State Lottery Fund for expenses in connection with the State Lottery.
